Fresh Fire or Strange Fire?
2: What He Said – Our O.S.

Text: Leviticus 10:1-7 / Eph 4:11-12

What has the Lord commanded and how are we doing?

Every good vision has 3 parts: A mission, a methodology. And a set of values. What are ours? How am I partaking in it?

Last time the Mission: “Open a fountain of My healing power in this place.” **QUESTION:** How am I being part of the Fountain? Pray, give, prepare, serve

We have a methodology (O.S.) and a set of values. Today we look at our O.S. Repair, Prepare, and Celebrate.

The Repair and Prepare part comes from the Greek word for “Equip” in Eph 4:12 *Katartizo*. The celebrate part comes from the tabernacle of David description in Heb 12- a festal gathering!!!! the need to stay focused on Him and His faithfulness. Heaven is a happy place.

- 1) **Repair** broken people: Eph 4:11-12
 - a) Equip (KJV Perfect) *Katartizo*:
 - i) Mk 1:19 Mend
 - ii) Gal 6:1 Restore
 - b) Humans are broken in all three areas
 - i) Spirit – Ye must be born again Jn 3:3-8
 - ii) Soul = the mind the will and the emotions.
 - Renew the mind
 - Consecrate the will
 - Bring the emotions under the spirit
 - iii) Body:
 - Matt 8:16-17 Is 53:4-5)
 - James 5:13-16
 - iv) **QUESTION** Am I being repaired?
- 2) **Prepare** willing people: Eph 4:11-12
 - a) You have a gift 1 Peter 4:10-11 .

- b) I am here to be sure you have the opportunity to be prepared. It is my grace, and the grace on the house flows from it.
 - i) 1 Thessalonians 3:9-10 Your faith needs my (or somebody's) gift, and it is best done in person.
 - ii) 2 Timothy 3:16-17 the Scripture equips us for our purpose
 - iii) 2 Timothy 2:1-2
 - My job - stay steady in my grace and commit (not just teach) the message to faithful ones
 - Your job – Study (2 Tim 2:15), be faithful, teach others
 - iv) **QUESTION** Am I being prepared?
- 3) **Celebrate** the goodness of God:
 - a) The Lord is good! Whenever we get away from that truth, we are on the path of deception. James 1:16-17
 - b) Take of your sad rags, put on your glad rags. We're havin' a Party! Hebrews 12:22-24 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels, (23) to the general assembly (a festal gathering) and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect, (24) to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel.
 - c) Hebrews 13:15 Therefore by Him let us **continually** offer the sacrifice of **praise** to God, that is, the fruit of our **lips**, **giving thanks** to His name.
 - i) **QUESTION:** Am I part of the celebration?
