2Tim 1:1-6 Each day of our lives we make deposits in the memory banks of our children. ~ Charles (Chuck) Swindoll

- God is a parent
 - Father God God wants us to know He is our Father Rom 8:15
 - Jn 14:18 You are not an orphan. You are NOT parentless.
 - ➤ He loves your children more than you do. He doesn't expect you to do it on your own. Rom 5:8; Matthew 7:9-11; Luke 11:9-13
 - He has given the responsibility and authority to raise them to you
 - AUTHORITY/Responsibility to disciple. Matthew 28:18
 - Prov 22:6; Eph 6:4; Psalm 78:1-4; Deut 6:4-9, 20-25; Gen 18:19
- Parent + Supernatural = Supernatural Parenting
 - If you have children, you are a parent
 - If you are born again, you have the Spirit John 3:6/1Cor 6:19
 - You know the Father. Romans 8:15
 - > You hear His voice. Hebrews 12:25, John 10:3-4, John 14:24-26
- Train up Your Children Proverbs 22:6
 - > Proverbs 22:6 We have a divine mandate to train our children
 - Train = Chanak dedicate, train, initiate (in the Way to Go!)
 - We are to train children, grandchildren, spiritual babies, in the way they should GO! To be MATURE Christians
 - Parents... Don't raise kids... Raise up Adults!
 - Instruction in Righteousness 2 Tim 3:16 More than just Word
 - More than just telling Bible Stories and Do's/Don'ts.
 Make sure they know why. Get involved in helping them KNOW him and not just know about Him.
 - Family Time God is a quality time guy. Ps 91:1, Mathew 6:6
 - Share a meal Ps 23 table spread before the enemy.
 - Mark 1:35 Your family need special time together too.
 - Boldly go to the Father. Heb 4:16
 - > Discipline No GOOD parent enjoys this. God doesn't.
 - He'd prefer to not have to correct us. The purpose isn't to hurt us but to HELP. There's a great book in the Book Nook on God's Keeping System (The Chastening of the Lord)...

- Prov 13:24 If you love your children you will discipline them
- Train them up in how they should go... that means sometimes you have to say NO!

> Learn the difference between Repetition and Nagging

- Nagging is a form of critical pestering, finding fault with somebody repeatedly or otherwise reminding an individual of previously discussed dictates or advice, usually from a perspective of superiority.
- 2 Peter 1:12 Repetition With no charged attitude. Only a heart to impart truths that will bless and help your children. It is the mother of all learning Rom 10:17
- > Prayer Teach your kids how to pray. Luke 11:1; 2 Tim 1:1-6
 - Pray with your children about Family things... Let them see His hand at work.
 - They need to hear you pray! John 11:41-43
 - Pray for them Jesus does (John 17, Rom 8:34)
 - Paul prayed for all his spiritual children... Eph 1:16, Rom 1:9, Col 4:12, 1 Th 1:2, Philemon 1:4, etc...
 - Pray in the HOLY GHOST Rom 8:26-27

> Take Care of Yourself

- Physically, Emotionally, Relationally, Spiritually
 If you're on Empty you will have nothing to impart to anyone.
- Make sure you spend intimate time with Him... He will Help you with your kids... because He loves them more than you. Matthew 7:9-11
- You are a Supernatural Parent.
 - > You are not alone. He is with you. Hebrews 13:5
 - I don't know how to start. Learn from Him.
 - You Have the WORD
 - You have supernatural Equipment 1 Corinthians 12
 - You have His wisdom available to you James 1:5
 - > Parent through Him. You are a SUPERNATURAL PARENT!
