Faith Christian Fellowship Sunday, May 22, 2016 Healing Fire An Atmosphere for Miracles 1

TEXT: 2 Timothy 1:6-7 NLT This is why I remind you to fan into flames the spiritual gift God gave you when I laid my hands on you. (7) For God has not given us a spirit of fear and timidity, but of power, love, and self-discipline. Leviticus 9:23-24 - Leviticus 10:1-2

We are talking about this word: Desire Fresh Fire, not strange fire. In Acts 3:1-10 we found the first documented healing in the Book of Acts. Peter let us know that we have three things that allow us to do wonders: The Name, faith, and hands. We saw in Acts 4 that God is good and He wants you healed.

In Acts 5:12-16 we see a powerful move of the Spirit in healing the masses. Today we want to focus in on Verse 16: An atmosphere where all are healed without respect to methods

Here's the issue for today: How do we foster an atmosphere charged with the healing power of God.

First an overview, then we will dig a little deeper in the first two

- 1) 5 INGREDIENTS FOR A MIRACLE ATMOSPHERE
 - a) Start with Prayer. Acts 4:23-31
 - b) Let the Holy Ghost clean house. Acts 5:1-13.
 - c) Come Expecting. Proverbs 8:34.
 - d) Stifle Strife. James 3:16
 - e) Maintain peace. Romans 14:19
- 2) Start with Prayer. Acts 4:23-31
 - a) Quit praying the problem: Question: Can you find two other prayers in the acts or the Epistles? What can you learn from these prayers?
 - i) Pray who He is
 - ii) Pray what He said **Question**: What is your #1 need today? Find a Scripture that promises you your answer and form a prayer using that promise.
 - b) Refer the problem to Him: V 29 "look on their threats."
 - c) Two requests:
 - i) Boldness
 - ii) Power: stretch forth Your hand to heal
- 3) Let the Holy Ghost clean house. Acts 5:1-13.
 - a) Give room to the Holy Spirit to move

- i) He is a gentleman. If you want to play church, He will let you.:
- ii) Be bold to address sin. Let the Spirit move through you in correction. **Question:** How does known sin or disobedience in your personal life effect you and your Christian life?
- iii) Speak the truth in love. Jesus died for sinners of whom I am chief, but He doesn't want to leave them there.
- b) The cure is supernatural, not legalism
 - Legalism produces sin: Romans 7:9 I was alive once without the law, but when the commandment came, sin revived and I died.
 - This is an example of a Word of Knowledge bringing supernatural correction and judgment, 1 Cor 12: 7-11.
 Question: Describe an instance when you experienced one of the spiritual gifts for yourself or through another believer.
- C) Why is this particular offence so egregious as to merit dropping dead? Hypocrisy – pretense to enhance e reputation, a feigned sacrifice, while keeping back money for himself. Question: Hypocrisy means claiming some moral value, but not practicing it yourself. What areas of your life might fit this definition?
 - i) V 4. The property was theirs to do with as they wished.
 They owned it, they controlled it.
 - ii) The problem arose when they made a show of offering it to the Lord, but held back for their own profit. Question:
 - * Seeking adulation
 - Preserving selfishness
- d) Judgment comes first on those who damage God's temple. Compare with Acts 4:32 4:32 / 1 Cor 3:16-17. **Question**: What kinds of things do you think bring harm to the Church, His Body?
 - Hypocrisy in the area of finances and religious politics threatened the unity of the Body, a unity of heart and mind that made the flow of power possible. (Money and pride)
- e) Are we willing to entreat the Lord to clean up His House? 1 Peter 4:17 / Romans 3:18 / Proverbs 8:13
- f) Notice the result: Acts 5:13-16

Question: What would it be worth to regain the respect of the community, to see multitudes added to the Lord, and to have an atmosphere charged with healing power?
