Foundations for Healing
The Anointing 2

TEXT: Luke 4:16- 19 / Acts 10:38

We believe in healing. It is the perfect will of God all the time and every time. Not everybody gets it. There are specific things we can do to prepare people (and ourselves to receive what Jesus purchased for us)

5 areas of knowledge needed as a strong basis to receive: The Love of God / Our Righteousness in Him / How to use our faith / The flow of the anointing / How to keep what we receive

Learn to recognize and cooperate with the anointing. It is supernatural and comes from the Spirit. An anointing is a dispensation or empowerment of the Holy Spirit that separates a person to a particular office and/or empowers them to do a particular work. The healing anointing is an empowerment of the Spirit to minister healing to the sick. There is a tangible anointing for healing which flows to the sick person. There may be physical manifestations.

We need to learn to cooperate with the anointing

- ♥ Recognize it when you see it: Special anointings for various offices and kinds of service
 - Preaching Luke 4:18 / Teaching I Cor 3:6; II Cor. 1:21 / Ministry to the broken-hearted Luke 4:18 / Healing Acts 10:38 / Music Note David I Sam. 16:23
 - Other ministries and or jobs people are anointed to do. Ex. Administration, helps, children, hospitality, ...
 - Under the New Covenant, every believer is anointed for service. I John 2:20, 27 / I Peter 4:10 / 1 Pet 2:4-54. **You are anointed!!!** The believer-priesthood: are: Prayer Rev 5:8, Ps 141:2 / Praise Heb 13:15 / Giving Phil 4:18 / Serving Rom 12:1 / Good works Gal 6:9-10
- ♥ Tapping in to the flow in the service
 - Don't grieve the Spirit
 - Disorder and distraction may disturb others. Do not let your selfishness steal the healing that God provides.
 - Be open to His working - I Thessalonians 5: 19-22. .
 - He is grieved by corrupt practices in the church. Ephesians 4:30 / Notice Exodus 30:30-38. The holy anointing oil was not to be used for personal gain or show
 - The Spirit is grieved by rebellion. Isaiah 63:10. Be obedient to the flow that is going on in the service.

- **When the Spirit is grieved, people sense His displeasure.**

- The Holy Ghost is not touchy. We do not have to have perfect silence and order for Him to move.
 - Irreverence and disorder can and distract the minister. We need to learn to flow with the individual in charge. Learn to cooperate with the prophet -
 - II Kings 5. Notice Naaman the Syrian's healing. He didn't want to dip in Jordan, but the prophet said Jordan and Jordan it had to be.
 - Different men are anointed differently. 1 Sam 17:38-39 Wear your own armor
 - ◆ Look to the gift in the minister, Don't miss out like Nazareth did in Mark 6:1-6 Notice 1Co 3:1-4
 - Helps ministries are very important in this respect.
 - 1Co 14:39-40 ...**properly and in order.**
 - Be sensitive to the preferences and anointings on each minister. Helpers be alert to the flow. Stay plugged in
 - Music - 2Ki 3:15, Find out what the minister wants in music. When it is worship, be worshipful. Applause is neither praise nor worship
- ♥ Use your faith!
 - **Come to church in faith:** The gifts are here to repair and prepare you! Eph 4:11-16
 - **Get in agreement:** Corporate unbelief can hinder the flow of power. Ex. Israel at Jordan-Numbers 13,14 / Mark 6:1-5.
 - Unity brings oil: Ps 133
 - People must be brought agreement by teaching and instructing. Mat 18:19 NLT "I also tell you this: If two of you agree here on earth concerning anything you ask, My Father in heaven will do it for you.
 - Praise is a powerful unifier. Ps 100
 - **Use your personal faith** to receive. Individual unbelief keeps us from receiving. Mark 5:25-34 Faith taps into the anointing. Receive the anointing by faith.
 - Say it – what do you believe you will receive?
 - Do it – Act on what you said.
 - Don't be dissuaded– stand on what you got!
