Faith Christian Fellowship Sunday, December 2, 2018 A Supernatural Church 16: Supernatural Daily Life

TEXT: Ephesians 3:10 NLT God's purpose in all this was to use the church to display His wisdom in its rich variety to all the unseen rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. Psalm 103:7 / 1 Corinthians 2:1-5 (4b NLT I relied only on the power of the Holy Spirit)

Contend for the supernatural: raise up and release a supernatural people, the supernatural church God intends us to be. So far: God wants to use the Church, and He has created us to be connected in order to fulfill our purpose. The supernatural church is an "us" thing, not a "me" thing. We moved past the gateway of being filled with the Spirit. A supernatural church does church supernaturally!

Church has 5 basic functions: Worship - Pray – Make Disciples - Fellowship – Do Ministry (service). How do we do them supernaturally?

We saw the hand of God in molding lives into supernatural mission by establishing supernatural fellowship around the purposes of God. The Mission continues. Are you in?

God wants you to be supernaturally used in His service, in church, in the community, in Borneo, but somewhere! Ephesians 4:11-12 tells us this is the purpose of teaching you and helping you get well-er.

God will grace you to be a supernatural light in whatever vocation you are called into – Eph 4:1.

Today we Believe God for:

1) Supernatural Direction

- a) Proverbs 3:5-6. Quit worrying, start trusting, and expect guidance: Trust, lean not, acknowledge, and WALK
- b) If you are committed, your steps are ordered: Psalms 37:23
- c) Start a supernatural day:
 - i) Trust: review God's promises. Spend time with Him
 - ii) Lean not: Quit trying to figure everything out! Proverbs 16:9
 - iii) Acknowledge Him: In everything you do, He is your purpose for being there, and He is personally present to help you. Matthew 28:20b ... and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.
 - iv) WALK!!!!! Don't walk around or step over, look for what is in front of you.

2) Supernatural Interaction

- a) He will prepare hearts to receive you, or needs for you to meet. Acts 16:14 / Mark 1:41 NLT Moved with compassion, Jesus reached out and touched him. "I am willing," He said. "Be healed!"
- b) "But Pastor, What if I don't know what to say?" Matthew 10:20 NLT For it is not you who will be speaking—it will be the Spirit of your Father speaking through you. (Stephen Acts 6:10)

3) Supernatural Demonstration

- a) God wants to bless them more than you do and He has given you His Spirit to do all the heavy lifting.
 - i) Acts 1:8 Is He on you? If so, you have power
 - ii) 1 Corinthians 2:4b NLT I relied only on the power of the Holy Spirit.
- b) Gifts are given, but they often stay in the box.
 - i) 1 Cor 12:10. and to another activities that call forth miracles... (One New Man Bible)
 - ii) God is looing to do miraculous stuff through you, not me: Stephen: Acts 6:8 / Philip - Acts 8:6 / Ananias - Acts 9:10

c) Let's do activities that call forth miracles:

- i) Pray for guidance and opportunities
- ii) Live with a knowledge of His presence and purpose (Mark 16:15-20)
- iii) Move with compassion Lay on hands: a pat on the back, a firm handshake. Offer assistance, kindness, simple sympathy.
- i∨) Be emotionally and spiritually available
- d) Let's be a people that get the Holy Spirit back into daily life
