The Mystery of Marriage 2: Till Death Do Us Part

Last week we looked in the Scripture about the Mystery of the Church. We specifically talked about the imagery that Paul used by the Holy Spirit to illustrate the Mystery of the Church, Jesus & you!

When we see the Lord talking about marriage in the Bible it is applicable to our covenant with Christ. Today, we will continue looking at our relationship with the Lord through the Mystery of Marriage. **Eph 5:32**

I. Gen 2:18-25 - God instructs married couples to **leave** their past. The Marital relationship is to become the primary human relationship in a married person's life. Our relationship with the Lord is to become **our primary** relationship. We leave our past and establish a future in Him.

- Parable of the 10 Virgins. Matthew 25:1-13
- Isaac & Rebekah – A servant went on a long journey to find a wife for Isaac. After finding a suitable wife for him. The servant took her back to Isaac. She left her family. Gen 24
- Orpha & Ruth both left their families to join Naomi's sons. Ruth 1:4
 - A. We also are to leave where you came from, our old pattern of life, and form a new one with Jesus. Examples: Abraham, and the rich young ruler Matthew 19:21

Have you left and let go of your past? What is it that you are still holding onto?

- B. Lay aside those weights, sins, unforgiveness, bad attitudes, & trust in worldly things. Hebrews 12:2, Mark 11:25 Matt 5:23-24 James 1:21, Luke 12:33-34
 - C. Our covenant relationship with the Lord is to be primary and supersede all others. God's work is completely different than the world & requires a change in how we think. We are a new creation in a new family. Lay aside the past. 2 Corinthians 5:17
- II. Cleave to Christ
- A. A newly married couple must learn how to live together. New methods, new recipes, new circumstances, new decisions.
 - 1. Not her way. Not his way. But THEIR WAY.
 - B. Jesus has provided us a HOME. John 14:2-3
 - 1. God's way is our way; God's light is our truth; His truth is our life John 14:6. We renew our minds to this new way of thinking and living. Romans 12:2

What parts of the new life Jesus created for you to live with Him in have you not yet embraced?

C. We have become a part of a new family and learn and adapt to living in this new family. Live every moment with him. Marriage was so important God ordered a new couple to take 1 year to focus on their new relationship. Deuteronomy 24:25

D. Cleave to the one who will never leave you. Hebrews 13:5

In cleaving to Jesus we have access to all that is His because it's ours now too. What are you accessing today?

III. Prosper! Reproduce! Fill Earth! Genesis 1:28Msg

- A. Reproduction was a part of God's plan for marriage. It is intended to take place within the confines of marriage.
- B. Malachi 2:15 tells us the Father wants godly offspring. What are you doing to produce some? We should be bearing: Fruit of the Spirit, God's promises, & New Believers Mark 16, 2 Timothy 2:2

IV. Naked and unashamed Genesis 2:25

- A. Naked – isn't referring to nudity here. I means their relationship was open & honest. Jesus desires us to be transparent with Him without fear and allow Him to see & wash our flaws Eph 5:26
- B. Unashamed – Isn't about not being embarrassed, but is a picture of safety & confidence that He won't exploit your weaknesses.

V. Till Death do us Part

- A. John Gill's Exposition of the Entire Bible notes that cleave also meant "not depart from her as long as they live"
- B. In marriage it is the death of spouse that sees the marriage covenant fulfilled to its end. Romans 7:2-3
 - 1. This is why divorce is so devastating, because it provide a pre-mature and unnatural death to the marriage covenant.
- C. We have an everlasting covenant Hebrews 13:20-21
The Marriage of Christ to the Church never ends.
- D. We have received eternal redemption and eternal life. Hebrews 9:12, 1 John 2:25, John 17:3
- E. Jesus is eternal... The one who lives to die no more. John 1:1, Revelation 1:8
- F. He has done so much for us. Ephesians 5:25-31. The one thing we are asked to do in this GREAT MYSTERY of Marriage: Christ and You is to submit to Him who has given all for us. Eph 5:22

The Bible opens with the wedding of Adam & Eve and closes with the wedding of Jesus and His Church. In all His goodness and faithfulness to us let us endeavor to faithfully walk lives submitted to Him.

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
